CUPS, TROPHIES AND AWARDS

Cups will be held for one year.

The Martin Harriott Challenge Cup and RHS Banksian Medal – awarded on total number of points gained across **all** the classes of the competition.

The Arundel Allotments and Gardens Association Open Market Challenge Cup – this is limited to allotment holders in Arundel and will be awarded on total number of points gained across all the vegetable, fruit and flower classes.

6	Tallest sunflower	One specimen as a cut flower

7	Four different vegetables	1 specimen of each
8	Potatoes	5 tubers any one variety
9	Beetroot	3 roots
10	Carrots	3 roots

12	Onions	5 bulbs

COOKERY

30	Victoria jam sandwich, using 3 eggs
31	Fruit cake
32	A plate of plain shortbread
33	Jar of jam
34	Jar of marmalade
35	Jar of chutney
36	Jar of honey from own bees

CRAFT

37	Craft One: An item of the entrant's own craftwork not entered in this show before and not exceeding 12"x12"x12" in woodwork, metal, or pottery (or other 'hard materials')
38	Craft Two: An item of the entrant's own craftwork not entered in this show before and not exceeding 12"x12"x12" using 'soft materials' (eg wool, cloth or paper).

BEST SCARECROW

39	Best scarecrow with a Space Age theme. Size not exceeding 5 ft. Can be entered by an individual, family or group.
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PHOTOGRAPHY

40	Amateur photograph on the theme of "Having a Laugh". The print must be unmounted. Size either 4"x 6" (102x152mm) or 7"x 5" (180mm x 130mm).
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JUNIOR ARTWORK

Pupils from Arundel Church of England Primary School and St Philip's Catholic Primary School are submitting paintings on the theme of "A Garden on the Moon". The paintings will be on display during the show.

A word of advice to all competitors: please note maximum size of exhibits quoted! Entries may be excluded from judging if over-size.

Programme for the day:

- 9:00 am to 10:00 am: exhibits to be placed in hall.
- 2:00 pm: doors open for exhibitors and public to view the show.
- 2:00 pm to 3:30 pm: tombola – prizes to be won!
- 3:30 pm: prize-giving.
- 4:00 pm: exhibits may be removed.

We are grateful to the Mayor of Arundel, Carolyn Kenney, who will present the prizes.

Show Regulations:

1. The show will be conducted in accordance with the rules and standards of the Royal Horticultural Society Show Handbook, except where amended to meet the requirements of the organisers' own regulations. The judges' decisions are final.
1. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry and in the event of a refusal it is not required to give any reason or explanation.
2. The exhibitor, unless otherwise stated in the programme, must have grown all horticultural exhibits and made the cookery, woodwork and craft class entries. The photograph entered must have been taken by the exhibitor.
3. No persons to enter more than one exhibit in any one class.
4. All entries (including for photographs and scarecrows) are to be completed on the official form enclosed within the programme or by email with the required information.
5. No person may compete in the show unless the entry form is received by the time stipulated in the programme.

6. All exhibits must be staged ready for judging by the time indicated in the programme and late arrivals will not be accepted.
7. Exhibits must be in place between 9:00 am and 10:00 am and may not be removed from the show until after the prize giving unless authorised by a member of the committee.
8. The flower classes (1-6) will be exhibited in the vases provided.
9. For photographs, please do not put your name on the back of the print. Please bring your print to the show between 9:00 am and 10:00 am on the morning of the show. The Flower & Produce Show committee reserves the right to use the winning photographs in future show publicity.
10. The organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any exhibit during the show but all ordinary care will be taken.
11. In the event of a dispute over any matter connected with the show, not provided for in these regulations, it shall be decided by the committee whose decision shall be final. All complaints other than those made at the time of showing must be made in writing.
